MANNED GUARDING: STANDARDS AND THE COST CONUNDRUM

Security Industry has so far been unable to resolve the basic dichotomy between the cost implications of quality and the L1 syndrome implied by tendering processes where the dictum Maximum Quality at Minimum Price, operates. There is a need to modify certain norms in tendering platforms so that good intentions of the Government to provide better remuneration to the security quard and at the same time improve quality are translated into reality. This is essential in view of the fact that security industry is the largest employer of semi-skilled manpower in the country. Universal volunteered to subject themselves to the process and became the first agency to be qualified for Three Star Rating with the hope that more and more clients will opt for the genuine quality indicator. But the experience so far proved otherwise. Genuine costs towards higher quality need to be structured into the system.

It was envisaged that the certification would open new horizons for Universal and would be a formidable foundation for further growth.

But, on the reality front, it is observed that the end user, clients and Govt tendering platforms like GeM are unaware of the availability of the standards and still decide bids on L1 Criteria. Further to it, the guarding services require deliberate recruitment, constant upscale, supervision, training, relief, welfare etc which cannot be catered in the least service margins of 0.01% criteria being selected for contract by most of the end user clients and Govt Tendering platforms like GeM. Furthermore, a PSA is also bound to abide by the large number of statutory obligations.

Thus, these facts and concerns were communicated during the national level discussions between CAPSI Executive Board members, by Capt Uttam P Patil (retd), Vice President, CAPSI Maharashtra Chapter.

These views of our CMD, Capt Uttam P Patil (retd) have been published in the monthly magazine "Security Today" in its August 2022 edition, where these concerns have been widely covered.


