FIRE EXTINGUISHER INFORMATION / SAFETY INFORMATION

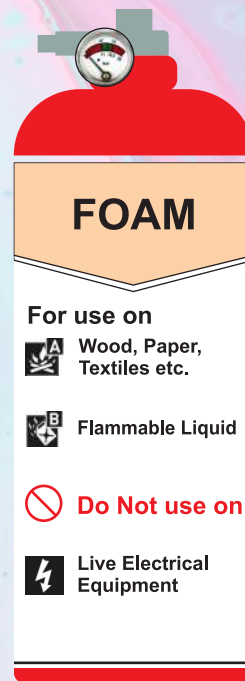
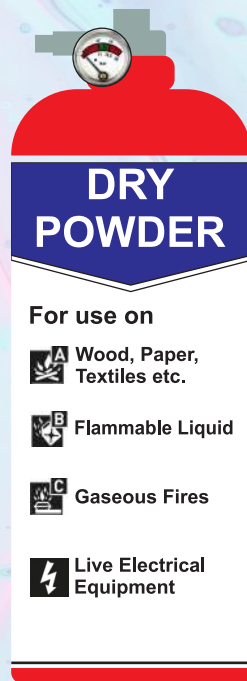
WHEN TO USE A FIRE EXTINGUISHER

Fire extinguishers can be helpful on a small fire. Consider the use of a fire extinguisher on a potential fire once all of the following conditions have been met:

- Have I alerted others in the building that there's a fire?
- Has someone called the fire department?
- Is the fire small and can be contained by using fire extinguishers?
- Am I safe from the fire's toxic smoke?
- Do I have a clear escape route?

Use a fire extinguisher when all of these questions are answered “yes”.

USING THE CORRECT FIRE EXTINGUISHER



CORRECT USE OF A FIRE EXTINGUISHER

P



1st Step

Pull the Pin. Hold the extinguisher with the nozzle pointing away from you and release the locking mechanism.

A



2nd Step

Aim low. Point the extinguisher at the base of the fire.

S



3rd Step

Squeeze the lever slowly and evenly.

4th Step

Sweep the nozzle from side to side
