The goal of training is for guards to learn and develop knowledge, skills and competencies in order to perform their jobs effectively. This involves being clear on what the guard needs to learn, i.e what are the tasks and roles that the guard needs to be able to perform. In the rapidly changing security scenario, guards must be trained to effectively do their jobs.

Here, on-the-job training is a highly critical component of the learning process. This is because it happens in real time and can have the highest impact on the guard's performance. Development is learning that goes one step further and has more long term focus. It is aimed at long term improvement in work capacity and performance.

Thus, with the focus on improvement of overall performance totally 99 training and development sessions were conducted including 18 online sessions for Guards, Supervisors, Security Officers, Cash Van Crew and Operations Staff during this quarter which ended on 30th June 2024.



"Initial Training of ESM MTS"

During this quarter, our team successfully deployed 292 Ex-Servicemen MTS, as a part of Western Corridor of the DFCCIL at two zones in Gujrat from New Palanpur to New Sachin within a distance of 486 Kms.

During this deployment, the Ex-Servicemen MTS were trained by our team and also by DFCCIL in different job profiles of Patrolman, Gateman, Keyman, Multi Tasking Staff in different departments of DFCCIL and Railway Protection Force.

Apart from the training as per the job profiles, our team conducted training sessions on general drill, emergency drill, soft skills, effective communication, leadership etc towards achieving predetermined goals and objectives as per the DFCCIL requirement.

मानसून के मौसम में सड़क सुरक्षा के सुझाव

1. अपने मोटर वाहन की जाँच करें - झूटी पर बाहर निकलने से पहले जाँच करें की वाहन पूरी तरह से चालू हालत में हैं। अगर आपको थोड़ी सी भी तकनिकी खराबी नजर आती है तो उसे ठीक करवा ले। सुनिश्चित करें की टायर, ब्रेक, टेल लाइट, हेड लाइट, वाइपर आदि पूरी तरह से काम करने की स्थिति में हैं। वाहन के टायरों में पर्याप्त हवा भरी होनी चाहिए।



2. मौसम की स्थिति के बारे में जानकारी रखें- मौसम के पूर्वानुमान पे नजर रखें और अपने झूटी क्षेत्र में किसी भी चेतावनी या सलाह के बारे में अपडेट रखें। बाढ़ वाले या जल भराव वाले मार्गों से बचें। सड़क बंद होने की स्थिति में वैकल्पिक मार्गों के बारे में जाने।



3. सुरक्षितता के साथ वाहन चलाएं- हमेशा दूसरे वाहनों से दूरी बनाये रखें। गति सीमा से ज्यादा वाहन चलने से बचें। प्रतिकूल मौसम, दृश्यता कम होने की स्थिति में या फिसलन भरी सड़कों पर बेहतर नियंत्रण बनाये रखने के लिए वाहन धीरे चलाएं। अनावश्यक ओवरटेकिंग से बचें और लेन बदलते समय इंडिकेटर का उपयोग करें।




4. लाइट और विंडशील्ड वाइपर का उपयोग करें - भारी बारिश होने पर दृश्यता कम होने की स्थिति में हेडलाइट और टेल लाइट चालू करना महत्वपूर्ण है क्योंकि इससे न केवल चालक की दृश्यता बढ़ती है बल्कि आपका वाहन दूसरे चालक को भी दिखाई देता है। विंडशील्ड वाइपर का इस्तेमाल करने से कांच पर नमी जमने से रोका जा सकता है।



5. आपातकालीन स्थिति के लिए इमरजेंसी किट तैयार रखें जिसमें प्राथमिक चिकित्सा किट, जरूरी दवाईयां, अतिरिक्त जूतें, एक टोर्च, एक छाता / एक रेनकोट और पावर बैंक शामिल हो। साथ में एक वाटरप्रूफ बैग हो जिसका झूटी के दौरान नगदी और दस्तावेज की सुरक्षा में उपयोग किया जा सके। सुनिश्चित करें की आपका मोबाइल फ़ोन चार्ज हो और उसमें आपातकालीन संपर्क सहेजे गए हैं।
