
Healthy tradition of awards and felicitations for going the extra mile for our clients has been kept uninterrupted by our personnel in the field. Kudos to them.

FIRST AID FOR ELECTRIC SHOCK

If anyone suffers an electric shock, the electricity source should be cut off immediately. Only conduct the first-aid when the victim is in a safe place. Check the victim's breath and pulse. If the person is unconscious but is breathing, he or she should be placed in a recovery position. If the victim is not breathing and has no pulse, Cardiopulmonary resuscitation should be conducted.

Note : Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation should be carried out only by Competent First-Aid personnel.

<p>1</p>  <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Shout for Assistance• Get someone to dial 108 immediately• Ask for Ambulance	<p>2</p>  <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Lay person on their back open their airways• Gently tilt head back and lift the chin (not for infants)• Remove foreign matter from mouth (and nose of baby)
<p>3</p>  <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Look, listen and feel for breathing• If normal breathing is present leave OR place patient on their side.	<p>4</p>  <ul style="list-style-type: none">• If normal breathing is absent, commence CPR• CPR 30 compressions to 2 breaths at 100-120 compressions/min
<p>5</p>  <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Continue 30 Compressions to 2 breaths• Interruptions to chest compressions must be minimized.	<p>6</p>  <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Repeat 30 Compressions to 2 breaths until an Ambulance arrives
<p>Child & Adult</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Place heel of hand on the lower half of the sternum in the centre of the chest.• Compress sternum one third the depth of the chest 30 times at the rate of 100-120 compressions per minute.• Continue with 30 compressions to 2 breaths .• Interruptions to the chest compressions must be minimised.	<p>Infant</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Position 2 fingers on the lower half of the sternum.• Depress sternum approximately one third the depth of the chest.• Continue with 30 compressions to 2 breaths.• Interruptions to the chest compressions must be minimised.

Attach Defibrillator

- Attach Automated External Defibrillator (AED) as soon as available and follow prompts.
- CONTINUE CPR UNTIL PARAMEDICS ARRIVE OR RESPONSIVENESS OR NORMAL BREATHING RETURNS.
- Beware of rescuer fatigue, if help is available swap rescuers every two minutes.
